Youth/ Young Adult Ministry Leader

The **International Protestant Church** of Brussels, Belgium, an English speaking, intentionally international and multi-denominational congregation ministering in Brussels, is seeking a dynamic, innovative, Christ-centered person to join our staff as the Intern Youth Ministry Leader.

To be eligible, you must be a committed Christian, have a minimum of a Bachelor's degree or equivalent with study or experience appropriate to Youth Ministry or Youth Education, be a minimum of 22 years of age and be eligible to work as an intern in Belgium. You will work within a community of young people from diverse, multicultural and multinational backgrounds and so must be comfortable in written and spoken English and open to working with people from a wide variety of Christian traditions and nationalities. You must be excited about working with teens and young adults, yet capable of providing an adult role model at all times.

The position is part time with a major emphasis on Youth and Young Adult Ministry and Christian Education. Participation in the worship life of the congregation will be developed in cooperation with the pastor and may include pulpit responsibilities, based on the interest of the Intern.

The purpose of the internship is to continue and, with the assistance of lay volunteers, direct a program of intentional and meaningful ministry with the youth (11-18 years) within the IPC family. Sunday morning Youth Christian Education and Youth events are a part of this position as is building a supportive relationship with youth and their parents, providing leadership in discipleship activities and participating in the general life of the congregation. Developing and nurturing a ministry to and with Young Adults is an expanding potential for ministry within the life of the congregation and coordination of this ministry will also be a part of the internship role

The position provides:

- 6.000 - 7.200 Euro per annum stipend, dependant on experience/training
- Paid training and conference opportunities through AICEME (the Association of International Congregations in Europe and the Middle East)
- Appropriate holiday time plus accommodation for Belgian holiday time
- Flexible work hours to accommodate study, research and/or other responsibilities
- A public transport (STIB) pass, if necessary
- Education/research leave to be negotiated with the Pastor and advising committee

The position will be under the direction of the Congregation's Human Resources Team and under the supervision of the Pastor.
