In the main hall there will be **continuous worship**, even during the breaks (which will take place in the other hall). The sessions start about **10am, 1pm, 4pm, 7pm**. You're of course free to come for one or more parts. There will be **prayer stations** in the hall. The music bands and prayer leaders come from all over the country. At 1pm teams will also go out for **outreach** in the city.

Transport: with public transport: from Central Station, take metro line 5 to Herrmann-Debroux station; by car: parking is free in the nearby Carrefour car park.
